- 3. To follow the phenomenon of multipolarity in the new international system, and the possibility of conflicts and disturbing imbalances in the balance of international relations, which can negatively affect the situation, especially in the MENA region.
- 4. To emphasize the central role of Iraq as an actor in the solutions proposed to address regional and international problems, and to show the role of think tanks in engaging in the process of addressing tensions and providing outputs that deal with crises in a spirit of scientific solution.
- **5.** To give a special attention to the prospects of the global economy, to allocate an appropriate space to the topic of human capital development, to present new and ambitious programs that aim to develop it, and to adopt qualitative initiatives to enhance training and develop skills and experience in a way that meets the requirements of the labor market and facilitates integration into it.
