## Dr. Haithan al-Jabouri:

The report of Alhurra channel included many fallacies and deception, and it is far from professionalism and neutrality in proposing and adopting the opinions. Here, it is our duty to clarify the following points:

- 1. Most projects of the two Husseini and Abbasid thresholds are educational, health and social care projects operated by specialized Iraqi and foreign bodies who require huge amounts, and the work of trade projects done by the holy thresholds is to meet the budget of the social and service projects and to develop them, and the purpose is not to trade.
- 2. With these service and social projects, the holy thresholds filled a huge gap left by the State's institutions in important aspects related to the Iraqi human, his health and education.
